Registration Requirements

The following is required to complete registration.

- 1. \$100 deposit payable by Credit or Cash/Debit
- 2. Annual Update forms completed and submitted
- 3. Current headshot photo of child submitted

- o Copy of Funding Agreement on file (FSCD, PDD, Children's Services etc.) OR
- Funding confirmation communicated in writing to AdaptAbilities from funder
- Invoice(s) signed

Parental Cost Shares

All funds not paid by funder are the responsibility of parent/guardian.

- Parental cost shares for all registered weeks paid in full by Friday June 1st, 2018
- NEW: \$100 deposit will be applied against cost shares

 - In Person (Cash, Debit, Pre-Authorized Withdrawl)

Cancellations

- Cancellations must be received in writing (registration@adaptabilities.ca). Voicemail cancellations will not be accepted.
- 30+ days prior to the first day of scheduled camp: Funder not billed, parent cost share refunded, and 50% of deposit forfeited
- 14-30 days prior to the first day of scheduled camp: Funder not billed, parent cost share refunded, 100% of deposit forfeited
- Less than 14 days prior to the first day of scheduled camp: No refunds
- Eligible refunds provided within 10 business days of written cancellation.

Deposit Refund

o For any child AdaptAbilities was unable to accommodate, deposit refunds will be issued in September 2018.

Medical Cancellations

- Refunds will be issued to individuals cancelling due to illness when substantiated by a medical note from the doctor.
- Medical notes must be received within 10 business days of notification of cancellation to be eligible for a refund.
