ACTIVITY	MATERIALS PROVIDED	MATERIALS NEEDED + INSTRUCTIONS
SPONGE TOSS	Sponge (2) Paper Plates (5) Markers Paper	<i>Bowl of Water</i> Write values on your paper plates - 5, 10, 25, 50, 100. Decorate the plates with your markers however you like. Make a score sheet with rounds 1-5 on the top, and both player names on the side. Head outside! Line the plates up vertically with the lowest value close to you, and the highest away from you. There are 5 rounds. For the first, stand one foot away from the first plate, the second, stand two feet away, and so on. Toss both sponges one at a time, aiming for the highest value. Write down your score, and take turns!

WATER BALLOON TOSS	Bristol Board (1) Balloons or water balloons (10) Faucet Scissors Markers	On the bristol board, draw three circles large enough for fully blown up balloons to go through. Have RCS help cut out the holes. Give each one values - 25, 50, 100. Decorate as you wish. Fill the balloons with water and stand different distances away, tossing the balloons, trying to get them through the holes and get the most points!
FAIRY DOUGH	Conditioner Cornstarch Glitter Food Colouring	In your large bowl, mix the conditioner, food colouring, and glitter. Add in the cornstarch and mix with a spoon until almost dry but not crumbly. Knead with your hands until fluffy. Remove and play!

	Blue Paint Yellow Paint Q Tips Paint Brushes Scissors Glue Stick Pencil	<p>On your dark green paper, draw the shape of the dragon head. Cut it out.</p> <p>Mix the blue and yellow paper until it is green. Dip the q-tips in and dab all over the dragon head, making it look like scales. Set aside to dry.</p> <p>On the light green paper, draw the ears, eyebrows, and other details. Cut them out.</p> <p>On the orange paper, draw the fire and cut it out. Draw the eyes and nose on black paper and cut it out.</p> <p>Once dry, glue all the pieces on to the dragon head!</p>
